- Director's Report: Mary McCarthy spoke on behalf of Mr. Moan regarding choir and reminded parents of the Fall Choral Concert coming up on October 4th. The concert will include the KSD 140 and Central Middle School Choirs. She also reported that the Marching Band would be appearing live on Fox News Friday Pep Rally along with the members of various student organizations and sports programs.

He reminded parents about the final performances of the marching season including Prospect Invitational on Oct. 6th followed by the Community Show, Providence Invitational, Illinois State Competition and Belleville and BOA as the final runs of the season. He reported that the show is coming along and that the closer will be performed for the first time at the Community Show.
